

CALCULATING GRADE POINT AVERAGE

To calculate your semester Grade Point Average, follow these steps:

- Find the grade point total for each class. To do this, multiply the number of credits the class is worth by the Quality Points value for the letter grade received.

Ex. 3 hour class with a grade of B+ (3.33 quality points) = 9.99 points

$$\begin{array}{rcccccc} \text{Semester Grade} & \rightarrow & \text{Quality Points} & \times & \# \text{ of credits} & = & \text{grade points} \\ \text{B+} & \rightarrow & 3.33 & \times & 3 & = & 9.99 \end{array}$$

- Do this for each of the classes that you received a grade in.

- Add together the grade points from each class.

- Next divide that number by the total number of credit hours taken. This will give you your semester G.P.A.

Ex. Semester Grade \rightarrow Quality Points \times # of credits = grade points

$$\begin{array}{rcccccc} \text{Total grade points} & \div & \text{Total credit hours} & = & \text{Grade Point Average} \\ 39 & \div & 13 & = & 3.00 \end{array}$$

Try to find out your G.P.A.

Quality Points \times # of credits = grade points
